

**Curriculum and New Programs Meeting
November 3, 2008**

Opening Remarks

Dr. Ojemakinde greeted the committee members and distributed the agenda and minutes of the last meeting for review.

Minutes

The minutes of the October 6, 2008 meeting were read. It was noted that Dr. James Hill's name should be added to the attendance roster, and the spelling of Dr. Gervin Putzur's name should also be corrected. It was moved and seconded that the minutes be approved with the necessary corrections. The minutes were approved.

Old Business

***College of Education
Teacher Education***

Dr. Wilburn Campbell asked Dr. Audrey Bread to present the proposal to change the following course EDUC 2300 Mastery Learning to:

- EDUC 2200 Mastery Learning Reading
- EDUC 2201 Mastery Learning Mathematics
- EDUC 2202 Mastery Learning Writing

It was moved and seconded that the proposal be approved. The motion was approved.

***College of Sciences & Health Professions
Natural Sciences***

Dr. Joyce Johnson asked Dr. Kwaichow Chan to present the proposal for the Admission Requirements mandated by Regents Engineering Transfer Program (RETP) and Dual Degree Program conducted in conjunction with Georgia Tech for the Engineering Program.

It was moved and seconded that the proposal be approved with corrections. The motion was approved.

New Business

College of Business

Accounting, Business Information Systems and Marketing

Dr. Michael Rogers presented the proposal to delete LOGM 3210-Conflict Management and replace with LOGM 4225 – *Warehouse Management* in Major area (Area H).

The rationale for the proposal is that LOGM 3210 – Conflict Management is hereby deleted and replaced with LOGM 4225 – Warehouse Management. The College of Business Curriculum Committee and Industry Stakeholder suggested that any Logistics Program should have a course in “Warehousing.” MGMT 4100 – Organizational Behavior will be enhanced to include case studies in “Conflict Management.”

The proposal will be voted on at the next meeting.

Dr. Rogers presented the proposal to change course name and repositioning of course level LOGM 3220 – Supply Chain Management to *Contemporary Logistics*.

The rationale for this proposal is that students will be able to take an introductory course in Logistics (as a COB elective) without a prerequisite.

The proposal will be voted on at the next meeting.

Dr. Rogers presented the proposal to change course name and repositioning of course level LOGM 4220 – Introduction to Global Logistics to *Supply Chain Management*.

The rationale for the proposal is that due to the advanced level of information to be covered, Supply Chain Management should be assigned a 4000 level prefix.

The proposal will be voted on at the next meeting.

Dr. Rogers presented the proposal to change course name LOGM 3230 Legal Environment of Logistics Management to *Logistics Security*.

The rationale for the proposal is that a course in Legal Environment (MGMT 3105) is already listed in the COB Core (Area G): hence, the objective is to avoid duplication and to clarify course title. Logistics Security will focus primarily on logistics security challenges and strategies.

The proposal will be voted on at the next meeting.

Dr. Rogers presented the proposal to change course name LOGM 4270 Global Supply Chain Management to *Global Logistics*.

The rationale for the proposal is that a course in Supply Chain Management already exists, and Global Logistics focuses more on Logistics from a “global” perspective.

The proposal will be voted on at the next meeting.

Other Items

1. Dr. Campbell informed the committee that we have an 89% GACE passing rate. Math and Reading is being dealt with throughout the state.
2. Dr. Beard suggested that a change on the Classroom Management checklists be considered to assist teachers in everyway possible. Teachers from other areas are being hired to teach Math and Science in our county.
3. Dr. Leroy Bynum distributed a flyer for Fine Arts and Lyceum Performance Series to the committee. He wanted every member of the committee to be informed of the event dates, and he encouraged all to attend the events.
