1982 TEACHERS-OF-THE-YEAR

Dr. Mollie B. Terry and Mrs. Connie M. Leggett were selected as co-winners of the 1982 "Teacher of the Year" Award, presented annually during the Honors Day observance.

Both alumnae of the College and native Albanians, they were the 1982 choices in a campus-wide poll conducted among the student body. Finishing in a virtual tie for the prestigious honor, both Dr. Terry, an associate professor of business, and Mrs. Leggett, an instructor of mathematics, were honored as "Teacher of the Year."

Dr. Terry has been employed at the College in a number of secretarial, administrative, and academic positions since 1965; since 1970, she has been on the Division of Business faculty. A member of Alpha Kappa Mu and Delta Pi Epsilon Honor Societies, she received both the M.B.E. and Ph.D. degrees in business education from Georgia State University.

Mrs. Leggett, a member of Alpha Kappa Mu, earned the master's degree in mathematics from Atlanta University. She has been on the College's mathematics faculty since 1970. Prior to that, she taught in the Dougherty County public schools.
